## **FREE SUMMER CONCERT SERIES OPENS AT EASTGATE PARK**

Rock and roll comes to town at Garden Grove's first summer concert of 2010. On Thursday, July 8, at 5:30 p.m., the Garden Grove Community Foundation (GGCF) kicks off the concert series with Jumping Jack Flash, a Rolling Stones tribute band. Seven concerts will take place at Eastgate Park, located at 12001 St. Mark Street.

Returning to Garden Grove, Jumping Jack Flash pays homage to one of the ultimate legendary groups in rock and roll history. The tribute band's title is taken from the 1968 Rolling Stones hit of the same name.
